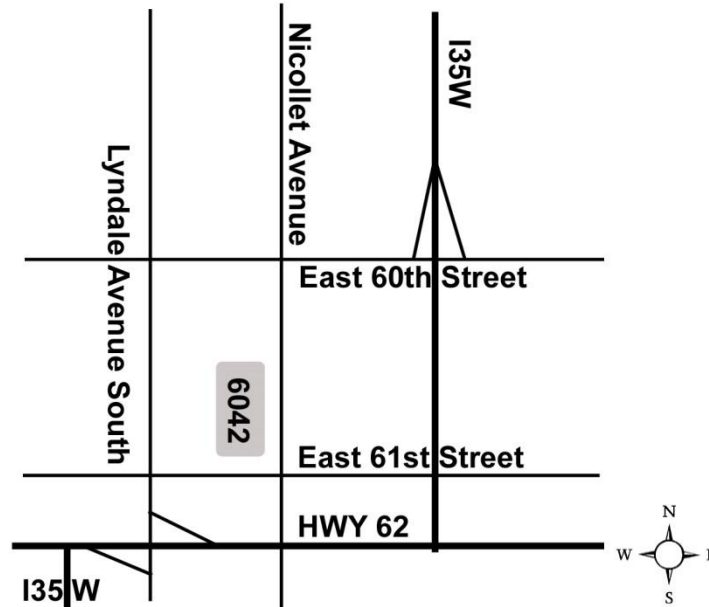

MINUTES FROM THE MEETING

On February 4th, 2017

President:

Dan B. called the meeting to order at 7:01pm. He thanked Lyle and Jerene for organizing the meeting place and thanked everyone for coming out. He also thanked her for the great dessert and the members agreed wholeheartedly!

Dan introduced the board members and reminded everyone that he's still looking for volunteers to fill the secretary, public relations, and membership positions.

Secretary:

Brian M. made a motion to approve last month's meeting minutes. Ted H. seconded the motion to accept the minutes as published.

Treasurer:

Jerene reported last month's beginning and ending balances. She explained that dues and swap vendor space fees had been collected. The club paid for WebWolf expense, mailing of the newsletter, GSTA entrance fees for two cars, and one other reimbursement for the Member of the Year plaque engraving. Deposits exceeded expenses. Dan asked if the members would like to see the dollar amounts listed in the Chevrolet. The club agreed to leave the amounts out of the newsletter. Vice President:

Committee Reports:

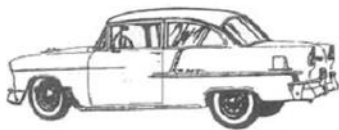
